Two additional casual staff and vehicles are available should additional resources be required. Supporting documentation was provided of its safety policy, safety system and safe work methods. A safety record was not provided.	The organisation demonstrated experience in performing similar services for Main Roads. It has managed weed control directly to Main Roads or as a sub-contractor for the past 8 years. It has a current three year contract with two year extension in place. It also completed herbicide spraying for the City in 2014 to kerbs, paved areas, median islands, mulched areas and small firebreaks.	Tiger Pest and Weed Control demonstrated a comprehensive understanding of the requirements. The management plan addressed pre-start, chemicals, signage, calibration of equipment, traffic management, training and a methodology with diagrams for spraying on ovals and spraying on kerbs/medians/paving/mulched areas. It has additional equipment and staff should it be required. A copy of the company's safety policy, OS&H management plan, sample JSA and safety record were provided.	Turfmaster Facility Management has prior experience in weed control to all types of infrastructure and landscaped areas such as parks, ovals, road reserves, and building surrounds. A general statement addressed this experience, however no specific information was provided of the period and dates of any contract. A list of clients was provided in the company profile, including the Cities of Wanneroo, Canning, Gosnells, Stirling, Swan, Cockburn, Vincent and Rockingham. The specific service provided to the clients was not detailed.	The company demonstrated a good understanding of the requirements.
