Visitors are encouraged to vote for their favourite artwork in the Popular Choice Award, proudly presented by Westfield Whitford City. Voting remains open until 25 July, with the winning artist receiving a \$500 Westfield Gift Card.

One of the highlights of the Community Art Exhibition is the opportunity to purchase original artwork. Every artwork on display is available for sale, giving visitors the chance to take home a unique piece while directly supporting local artists and contributing to Joondalup's creative economy.

Meet the judges

Sam Bloor



Sam Bloor is a visual artist from Perth, WA. He is interested in using the democratic nature of language to connect with audiences and reflect contemporary life. His work often moves between the small and personal scale (tattoos, mirrored objects), to the public and large scale (billboards, installations). Sam has exhibited in a number of group and solo shows

both nationally and internationally including: Totem In Tribute (2016) in Edinburgh, UK; the Fremantle Biennale (2019/23); and Rotterdam Photo Festival (2019), NL. He was commissioned to produce a major public work as part of the 2022 Perth Festival. Sam has won multiple awards, including the Fremantle Print Award (2019), the Rockingham Art Award (2024) and the City of Joondalup Invitation Art Prize (2025). His work has been acquired by private, public and institutional collections including the Art Gallery of Western Australia.

Sherry Quiambao



Sherry Quiambao is an Australian-Filipina artist based in Boorloo/Perth, WA. Her multidisciplinary practice spans photography, video and installation, often using everyday objects to explore memory, cultural heritage and consumerism. Her work has been exhibited nationally and internationally, including in the Philippines, USA, Indonesia and Japan.

Recent exhibitions include de-centre re-centre at Lawrence Wilson Art Gallery with Perth Centre for Photography as part of Perth Festival (2025), Veiled in Bloom at Michael Reid Northern Beaches (2025), and Veiled in a Golden Hue at Goolugatup Heathcote (2024). In 2025, she received the First Time Finalist Award in the National Photographic Portrait Prize at the National Portrait Gallery and was a finalist in the National Still Life Award and City of Joondalup Invitation Art Prize (2025). She is a recipient of the Minderoo Artist Fund (2026).

Anna Louise Richardson



Anna Louise Richardson is an artist and curator living and working on a cattle farm on Bindjerab Nyoongar Country in the Peel region. Her large-scale charcoal drawings focus on everyday rural life and complex relationships between people, animals, and the environment. Current projects include a national tour of her solo exhibition

The Good with Museums and Galleries of New South Wales. Richardson graduated from Curtin University in 2013 and has worked for Artsource, as curator for the John Stringer Prize, was inaugural lead curator of the WA Regional Art Triennial and participated in the Australia Council Emerging Arts Professionals Program at the 2019 Venice Biennale. She was a finalist in the City of Joondalup Invitation Art Prize (2025) and is currently working with John Curtin Gallery as Special Projects Curator.

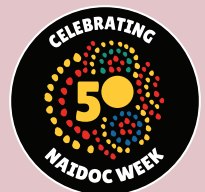
