Joshua Noronha

Sunday 19 July | 2 – 3pm

Start the series on a high note with an afternoon of exceptional piano as Joshua Noronha takes to the stage.

A previous Young Musician of the Year winner and multiple prize-winner at major national and international competitions, Joshua is recognised as one of Australia's most accomplished young pianists, known for his technical brilliance and expressive playing.

Featuring works by Rachmaninoff, Tchaikovsky, Chopin and Liszt, this captivating recital brings together some of classical music's most powerful and emotive works.

Don't miss the chance to experience one of the country's most exciting young talents live in concert.



Tara Tiba

Sunday 16 August | 2 – 3pm

Experience a sound that's rich, expressive and unlike anything else on the program, as Tara Tiba takes to the stage.

Blending traditional Persian vocals with jazz, Latin and contemporary influences, Tara creates a powerful and deeply moving live performance that draws on centuries of musical tradition.

Having performed at major venues and festivals around the world, including New York's The Met and WOMADelaide, she brings a distinctive voice and global perspective to every performance. Joined by her band, expect an afternoon of striking vocals, rich instrumentation and music that lingers long after the final note.



True Blue

Sunday 13 September | 2 - 3pm

Some of Australia's most iconic songs take centre stage in *True Blue*.

Led by vocalist Louise Anton and joined by The Collective string ensemble, this performance brings together powerful vocals, rich strings and beautifully arranged interpretations of well-known classics. Under the direction of Maestro Shaun Fraser, each piece is reimaged with care and attention to detail.

From iconic anthems to all-time favourites, this is a standout live performance that puts a new spin on the music you know, brought to life by an extremely talented ensemble.



A Boy Named Cash

Sunday 18 October | 2 – 3pm

Step into the world of Johnny Cash as Monty Cotton brings *A Boy Named Cash* to the stage.

With a voice strikingly close to the Man in Black, Monty delivers a powerful tribute to one of music's most iconic figures, performing the greatest hits that defined a generation.

This dynamic one-man show combines live vocals, guitar and percussion, creating a full-band sound that has earned sold-out shows at major festivals across Australia and the UK.

From unmistakable classics to crowd favourites, this is a high-energy performance that captures the spirit and sound of the legendary Johnny Cash.



Gypsy Swing Soirée

Sunday 15 November | 2 – 3pm

Sassafras brings a lively mix of swing, gypsy classics and French ballads to the stage in *Gypsy Swing Soirée*.

Led by double bassist Pete Jeavons and featuring the captivating vocals of Jessie Gordon, this accomplished ensemble delivers a vibrant acoustic performance shaped by intricate musicianship and expressive arrangements.

From the music of Django Reinhardt and Cole Porter to Edith Piaf and Jacques Brel, expect a dynamic set that moves between fast-paced favourites and more atmospheric moments, all performed with energy, precision and style.

Purchasing Tickets

Tickets can be bought from the City of Joondalup website via our ticketing provider, Ticketbooth.

You can also buy them in person from the City of Joondalup Administration Office, open 8:30am to 4:30pm Monday to Friday.

Companion Tickets

Ticket purchases made by a valid Companion Cardholder are eligible to receive an additional ticket for a carer or companion at no charge. Simply add the 'companion' ticket type to your cart when booking and enter your card number when prompted.

Cancellation Policy

If a show is rescheduled or cancelled, all ticketholders will be eligible for a refund. Any such changes will be communicated via email and on the City of Joondalup website.

In all other circumstances, tickets are not refundable. If you can no longer attend a concert, you are welcome to gift your tickets to a friend or family member.

Important Information

Venue: All concerts are held in the Redmond Theatre at Prendiville Catholic College, located at 11 Prendiville Ave, Ocean Reef.

Parking: A small number of standard and ACROD bays are located directly outside the theatre, with additional parking available on the nearby tennis courts.

Concert times: All concerts start at 2pm and run for 60 minutes. Doors open at 1.45pm.

Seating: All concert seating is unallocated, so sit wherever you like. All seats offer a clear view of the stage.

Accessibility: Redmond Theatre features a flat entry with wheelchair accessible seating area. We encourage you to reach out to discuss additional accessibility requirements.

Community Transport Program: The City offers a low-cost Community Transport Program to assist patrons who need support getting to and from the concerts. Get in touch to find out more.
