

# Name Our Waste Monsters Competition 2026

## Terms and Conditions

1. This competition is a trade promotion lottery (**Competition**) run by the City of Joondalup (**City**) in accordance with the *Gaming and Wagering Commission Act 1987 (WA)*.
2. Entry to the competition is free.
3. By submitting your entry, you acknowledge that you have read and accept these Terms and Conditions.
4. This competition is open to students in years 3 to 6 in schools within the City of Joondalup or ages 8 to 11. The following are ineligible to enter: Students outside of the age categories, and students not in a primary school within the City of Joondalup boundaries. Home schoolers within the age range (aged 8-11 at the time of the competition) can participate, however, there will be no prize for the 'school'.
5. This competition is open only for students within the year level boundaries at the time of the competition duration. The City reserves the right to disqualify any entrant who tampers with the entry process, who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions, or who has, in the opinion of the City, engaged in conduct in entering the Competition, which is considered fraudulent, misleading, or deceptive.
6. To enter the Competition, entrants must, during the Competition period, complete their design within the dedicated templates and submit with the timeframe allocated.
7. The competition opens on 26 April 2026 and closes on 1 July 2026.
8. The information that entrants provide will be used by the City for the purpose of conducting this competition, and the students first name, age/year level and school will be included in future marketing promotions. The City will not share any information collected with third parties. By entering this competition, entrants consent to use their contact details for the purposes described in this clause. This information will be collected, processed, used and protected in accordance with the applicable data security and privacy laws.
9. There will be one winner per monster – therefore three winners in total. Winners from the competition will be selected by a panel – Manager Waste Services, Manager Communication and Stakeholder Relations and a Waste Sustainability and Education Officer. Each winner will receive a \$100.00 visa gift card, and the respective school will receive \$500.00 to spend on waste related items, such as infrastructure, or a waste incursion or excursion e.g. a workshop or tour. The City reserves the right to request each winner to provide proof of their identity and/or proof of each winner to comply with any of the City's instructions on how to claim the Prize.
10. Each Prize is not transferrable, exchangeable or redeemable for cash. Once a Prize has left the City's premises, the City takes no responsibility for the Prize being damaged, lost or stolen.

11. If a Prize is unavailable for reasons beyond the City's control, the City reserves the right to substitute the Prize with a prize of equal or greater monetary value. This right is subject to any applicable legislation, regulations or directions from a regulatory authority.
12. A winner's use of the Prize is entirely at their own risk. Before a Prize is awarded, a winner may be required to sign an agreement to release the City from and indemnifying the City against any liability arising from the winner's acceptance and use of the Prize and the winner's participation in the competition.
13. The City will take all reasonable steps to identify and notify each winner to ensure that each winner receives their Prize. In the event of any prize left unclaimed, or the winner cannot be identified, by Friday 24 July 2026, the Prizes will be redrawn on Monday 27 July 2026, 12:00pm WST at the City of Joondalup Administration Building, 90 Boas Avenue, Joondalup, 6027.
14. The City will not be liable to any entrant who cannot be contacted or whose entry contains incorrect or misspelled information including email addresses. In such cases, this entrant forfeits any Prize, and no further correspondence will be entered into. The City will not accept late entries.
15. By entering this competition, entrants acknowledge that if they are a winner, photographs may be taken at the Prize collection for marketing and media purposes, and this will be done only with the winner's consent. Any such photographs taken, and copyright in the images, will belong to the City, and the City has the right to use these images without payment or other compensation to the Prize winner.
16. The City reserves the right to vary the terms of, or cancel, the competition at any time without liability to any entrant or other person, subject to applicable laws.
17. Any Prize supplied by a third party supplier is subject to the terms and conditions of that third party supplier. Each Prize may come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the applicable Australian consumer laws. If those guarantees are not complied with, then you will have rights under the applicable Australian consumer laws. Subject to those guarantees and rights, the City will not be liable and excludes all liability (including negligence) for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) for damage to property, personal injury or death suffered or sustained in connection with the competition or the use or taking of any Prize except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law including as provided for under the applicable Australian consumer laws.
18. If entry is via social media or if the competition is promoted on social media, the competition is in no way sponsored, endorsed, administered by or associated with the social media platform and each entrant agrees to grant the social media platform a complete release from any claims that they now have or may have in the future which relate to or are incidental to the competition. Entrants acknowledge and agree that:

  - b. any questions, comments or complaints regarding the competition will be directed to the City, not a social network.

## Information on the Prize

1. The competition opens on 26 April 2026.
2. The overall Prize is a \$100.00 visa gift card per winner, and \$500.00 to the school of each student. There are a total of six (6) Prizes and the total Prize pool is valued at \$1,800.00.
3. There will be one winner per Monster, three (3) winners total. Winners will be selected by a panel – Manager Waste Services, Manager Communication and Stakeholder Relations and a Waste Sustainability and Education Officer. Each winner will received a \$100.00 visa gift card, and the respective school will receive \$500.00 to spend on waste related items, such as infrastructure, waste incursion or excursion e.g. a workshop or tour.
4. Winner(s) will be notified via phone, email, or through the participating school.
5. The winners must collect their prize by 3pm Friday the 24 July 2026 in-person. Prizes must be collected during opening hours, Monday – Friday 8.30 – 5.00pm, at the City of Joondalup Administration Building, 90 Boas Avenue, Joondalup, 6027. The City will not be liable for any delivery or travel costs associated with claiming a Prize.
6. The City will take all reasonable steps to identify and notify each winner in an attempt to ensure each winner receives their Prize. In the event of any Prize left unclaimed or a the winner cannot be identified by Friday 24 July 2026, the Prize will be redrawn on Monday 27 July 2026, 12:00pm WST at the City of Joondalup Administration Building, 90 Boas Avenue, Joondalup, 6027.

## Entry Details

The Competition is open to students in Years 3 to 6 of schools located within the City of Joondalup during the Competition period. The Competition is also open to homeschool students aged 8-11 years who reside in the City of Joondalup. The following are ineligible to enter: persons whom are outside of the specified year groups; persons not a student of a school located within the City of Joondalup boundaries.
