



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CONCEPT PLAN – RESIDENTIAL YIELDS

The final number of dwellings (including single lot and apartments) is subject to final detailed design, compliance with the *Ocean Reef Marina Design Guidelines*, the size of the lots to be available for development (both single lot and apartments), market demand and what the ultimate development of each lot proposes.
