## 3. ITEMS OUTSTANDING FROM PREVIOUS MEETINGS

#### 3.1 MOORO COUNTRY TOUR

Mr Reay explained to the Committee that the planned tour organized with the Northern Suburbs Reconciliation Group (NSRG) would need to be postponed due to unforeseen circumstances. It has been recently bought to the attention to the City that a member of NSRG need to consult with the Native Title Claimants, and as such the planned tour will be rescheduled upon conclusion of this matter.

## 3.2 SWAN REGIONAL STRATEGY

# 4.1 DEPOT CONCEPT PLAN PRESENTATION

Mr Main presented to the Committee the current concept plan for the new Depot building design. The Committee was presented the proposed ecological sustainable design principles and plans of the proposed site. Concept detail was presented, primarily due to the early stage of development. Detailed design process will fully identify the ESD principles. Mr G Down expressed concerns relating to thermal performance of the

building relating to poor solar orientation. Mr Main indicated that some consideration had been given to such issues. Other general issues were raised from Committee members and Mr Wesley indicated that the Committee would be kept informed of developments regarding the Depot.
