It is used late at night for a race track, which could be a noise/safety issue for pedestrians. Since paving the laneway a few years ago, the number of vehicles using the lane way have increased which presents a safety problem. Traffic while not considered heavy outside of peak hours, is reasonably constant, especially at weekends. Traffic queues in the laneway in the mornings, which would affect the adjoining properties. The front gardens of the adjoining properties are sometimes driven over by vehicles. There would be minimal if any adverse effects on traffic flow in the area. The lives of the local residents would be greatly enhanced by the cheap and effective measure, which could be removed at any time if conditions were to change. 	Supported. However in regard to point 5, this would be a permanent closure to vehicles at that point where the laneway is closed.
