
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#### INTRODUCTION

The City has developed an Integrated Planning Framework, which is structured to ensure operational activities are being driven by the strategic priorities of the organisation. The Strategic Plan 2003 – 2008, a key component of this planning framework, is the overarching plan that provides direction for all activities and guides the development and provision of all the City's services and programs. The Strategic Plan is currently being reviewed by the Council for the period 2008-2011.

The Integrated Planning Framework is made up of a series of plans to implement the City's Vision to be a sustainable City and community that are recognised as innovative, unique and diverse.

The Framework includes:

- The Strategic Plan which provides broad future strategic directions for the City. It is Council's most important strategic document and contains strategic directions and objectives for the City as a whole;
- The 20-Year Financial Plan which provides a broad overview of the major projects, programs and resource requirements over the next 4 years (The Plan includes 20-year financial projections);
- The Annual Plan which contains annual actions to achieve the vision of the Strategic Plan 2003 2008;
- Directorate Plans contain details of annual projects and programs to be delivered by each Directorate;
- Business Unit Action Plans contain details of the annual programs, services and activities for each Business Unit, and
- The Annual Budget.

Quarterly progress reports against the Annual Plan provide Council and the community with a full assessment of the City's progress in relation to the achievement of pre-determined milestones for major projects and programs.

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# INTRODUCTION

The City of Joondalup's integrated planning framework starts with a vision for the City as outlined in the Strategic Plan 2003 – 2008, and includes a series of plans and reporting mechanisms to implement the vision. The Strategic Plan is currently being reviewed by the Council for the period 2008-2011.

The framework includes the:

- Strategic Plan which provides broad future strategic directions for the City. It is Council's most important strategic document and contains strategic directions and objectives for the City as a whole;
- 20-Year Financial Plan which provides a broad overview of the major projects, programs and resource requirements over the next 4 years and includes 20-year financial projections;
- Annual Plan which contains annual actions to achieve the vision of the Strategic Plan 2003 2008;
- Business Unit Action Plans which contain details of the annual programs, services and activities for each Business Unit, and
- Annual Budget

The Strategic Plan provides broad future strategic directions for the City and directly informs the Annual Plan and, consequently, all Council operations and activities.

The Strategic Plan is developed around four key focus areas within which strategic directions and objectives for the City are articulated. The four key focus areas are:

- Community Wellbeing;
- Caring for the Environment;
- City Development; and
- Organisational Development

The Annual plan contains annual actions to achieve the vision of the Strategic Plan 2003 – 2008. The Annual Plan actions are derived from the Strategic Plan, and address Council priorities.

The Quarterly Progress Reports against the Annual Plan provide the Council with information on progress against the pre-determined milestones for major projects and programs, and highlight the City's commitment to monitoring and reporting progress against objectives.

# **KEY FOCUS AREA 1 - COMMUNITY WELLBEING**

## Jinan Sister City Relationship

The City of Joondalup delegation to Jinan in China in September 2007 provided the opportunity for further development of the strong ties between the two Cities. Following an invitation from the Jinan Foreign Affairs Office to attend the Jinan International Tourism Fair, representatives from the City, the Police Academy, Edith Cowan University, West Coast TAFE, Joondalup Resort, Joondalup Business Association, Joondalup Health Campus, Sunset Coast Tourism Association and Woodvale High School discussed trade and educational opportunities and promoted Joondalup to the Jinan community.

## Children's Book Week

Children's Book Week was held in the City of Joondalup Libraries from 18 to 25 August with a total of 1,895 primary school students and local children attending. World-class authors, illustrators, storytellers and drama facilitators led the workshops.

### NAIDOC Week Celebrations

NAIDOC (National Aborigines and Islanders Day Observance Committee) Week is a nationwide celebration of the history, culture and achievements of Australia's Indigenous people. The City of Joondalup was proud to host a range of activities during NAIDOC week to acknowledge the importance of local Aboriginal culture. Events included an official flag-raising ceremony, an exhibition by contemporary Indigenous artists at the Blend(er) Gallery, performances and educational workshops conducted by an Indigenous theatre company, Yirra Yaakin. These events were held throughout the City at all Libraries and the Woodvale Day Care Centre and attracted more than 200 people throughout the week.

### 2007 Community Art Exhibition

Over 130 local artists took part in the 2007 Community Art Exhibition, held at Lakeside Shopping City from 25 July to 11 August 2007, showcasing the artistic diversity and talent within the City of Joondalup. The event attracted around 5,000 visitors over the two weeks, with

many artworks being sold. Padbury resident, David Anderson, was the overall winner, and received the prize of \$1750 for the most outstanding artwork, a painting entitled *Steve in Robes.* 

# Joondalup Eisteddfod

The annual City of Joondalup Eisteddfod was a great success for 2007, attracting over 2,000 performers in 114 sections which included singing, public speaking and instrumental music. A Trophy Winners' Concert was held on 28 September 2007.

Council's endorsement of the City's Environment Plan 2007 - 2011 and Greenhouse Action Plan 2007 - 2010 in September 2007 will provide future direction to the City's environmental activities.

This Plan builds on the significant progress made since the commencement of the City's first Greenhouse Action Plan 2003 - 2007.
