163-signature petition requesting the use of hydrothermal weed control technology instead of chemical spraying wherever possible.	27 February 2007	Progressing	<p>Report was presented to Council on 28 August 2007 which resolved to seek a further report – Refer CJ170-08/07.</p> <p>At the Council meeting held on 19 February 2008, the following was resolved:</p> <p><i>“That Council LISTS for consideration as a part of the 2007/08 half year budget review \$25,000 to undertake a 12-month trial of hydrothermal weed treatment, and additional submissions be sought.”</i></p> <p>The hydrothermal weed control trial is in progress. Updates have been included on the Desk of the CEO, with a report to be presented to Council in 2009.</p> <p><b><u>Update</u></b></p> <p>The report is currently being prepared and consultants are working on an attachment to the report. The report is anticipated to be presented to Council in April/May 2009.</p>

24-signature petition in relation to traffic problems on Coolibah Drive, Greenwood	27 February 2007	Completed	<p>The petitioners have all been written to and advised of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bus stop opposite of school to be relocated to 80 Coolibah Dr, (Consultation with owners completed and works have been programmed subject to availability of Brick Paving contractor, once works completed PTA will be advised to relocate stop) - This relocation will allow vehicles to pass the bus and reduce traffic build up and subsequent road rage.</li> <li>• Bus times on school side have been modified to reduce the waiting period and double up of buses at peak time.</li> <li>• Vehicle that was on wrong side of road in photo supplied has been issued an infringement.</li> <li>• Police are regularly patrolling school zone.</li> <li>• Dept of Education to consider funding additional off street parking in embayment on school side and to consider allowing the embayment to be used as a bus stop, which will allow PTA to remove the stop/shelter from outside school, and further reduce the congestion - This is the long term solution</li> </ul> <p>Additional information: For time being the City has completed what is necessary to alleviate the situation. Now it requires further input from Dept of Education. Note that Greenwood Train Station may be getting buses (ie bus station) in which case some of these bus routes/times may be modified to further reduce congestion.</p> <p><b>It is recommended that Council NOTES the response to the petition in relation to traffic problems on Coolibah Drive, Greenwood.</b></p>
