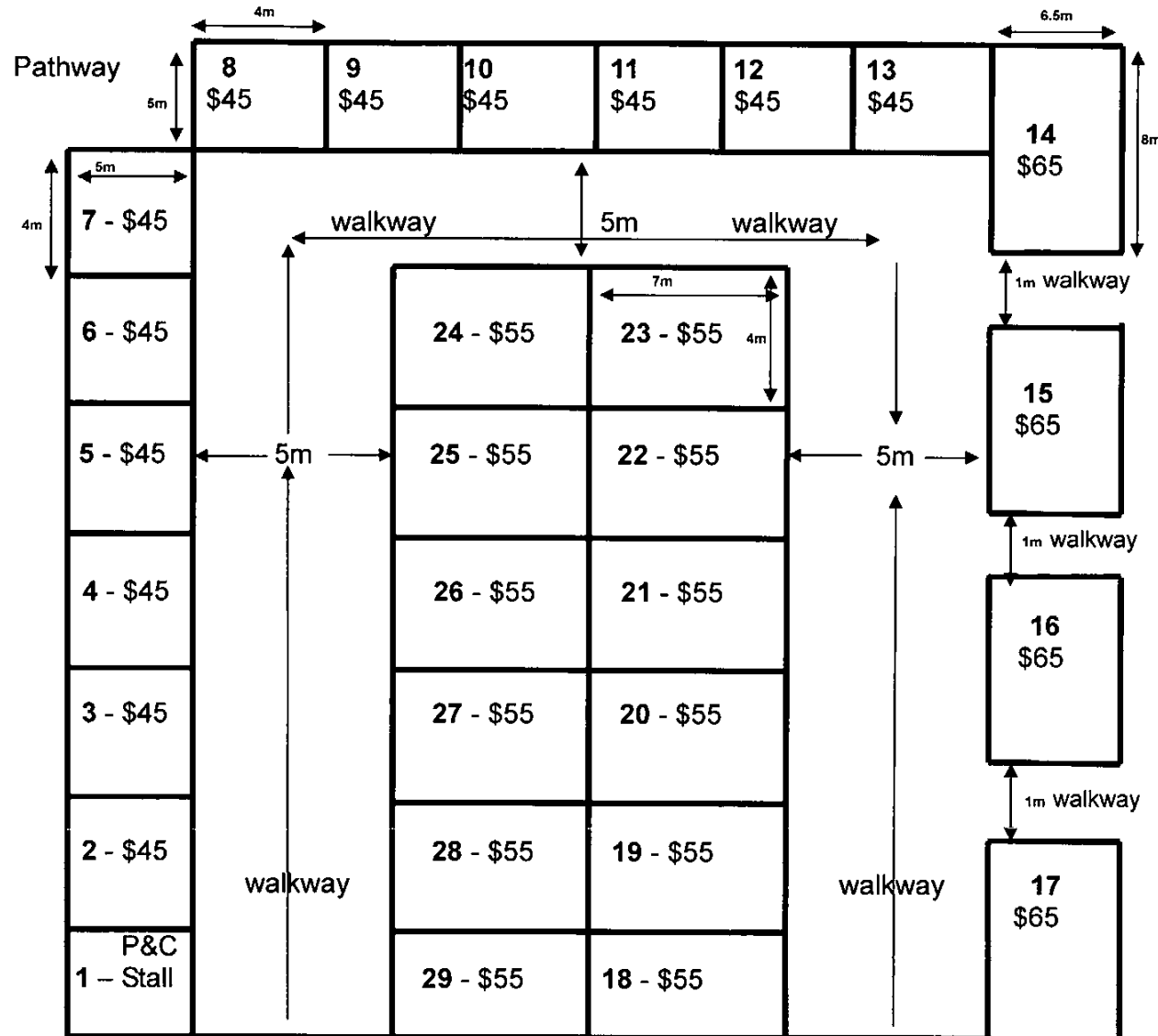

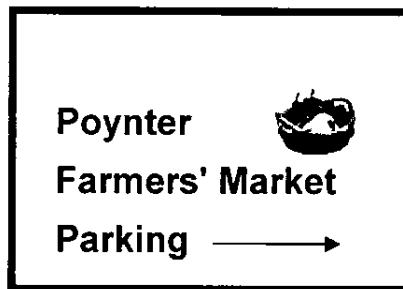

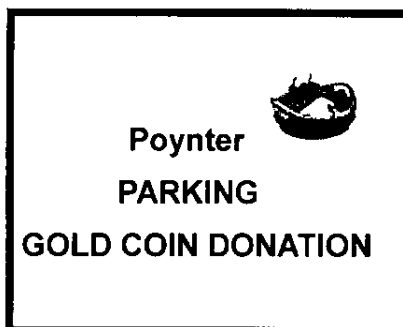


Parking and Traffic Management strategies

- 1 - Parking for the market is provided by using the school oval grounds. (see attached diagram of the oval).
- 2 - Four voluntary parking attendants will be on site to direct traffic in an orderly manner in the school grounds.
- 3 - A one way traffic system will be employed with signage facilities to ensure orderly traffic flow for vehicles entering and exiting the parking area's.
- 4 - The parking attendants must wear safety vests in line with the Occupational Health and Safety regulations and policies and thus, ensuring the attendants are highly visible to traffic at all times.
- 5 - Poynter Primary will provide directional signage to inform drivers of parking facilities and located on the fence lines of the school grounds and so the driving public can find their way to oval. These signs will be put into place each Saturday morning, prior to the start of the market day and removed at the end of the market day.



Also a sign will be placed at the entrance along the fence line of the oval stating a gold coin donation to the respective P&C and or community organisation is requested.



6 – Voluntary Parking Attendants will come from various P&C's and/or community organisations and will be rostered to perform these duties. Safety vests will be provided by the PFMC (Poynter Farmers' Market Committee) and returned to the management

when the market closes each week. The Market Manager will ensure the upkeep of the roster system.

7 - All proceeds of the gold coin donation will go back to the P&C's and/or community organisations.

8 – The school oval will be used to accommodate up to 200 car bays, with special ACCROD parking permitted to the overflow carpark. (see attached site diagram)

9 - Stallholder Parking will be provided and outlined on the attached site diagram. (see attached diagram)

STALL NUMBERS

Stall numbers are dependent on seasonal factors; that is, when produce come and at what times of the year and therefore, the following factors are considered;
