# Annual Plan 2010-2011 Progress Report

July to September 2010

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#### Introduction

The City's Planning Framework is structured to ensure operational activities are being driven and delivered in alignment with the strategic priorities of the organisation. The Strategic Plan 2008 – 2011 is a key component of this planning framework. It is the overarching plan that provides direction for all activities and guides the development and provision of the City's services and programs through the five Key Focus Areas of:

- Leadership and Governance.
- The Natural Environment.
- Economic Prosperity and Growth.
- The Built Environment.
- Community Wellbeing.

The Planning Framework is made up of a series of Plans to implement the City's Vision to be a sustainable City and community that is committed to service delivery excellence and operates under the principles of good governance. The City's mission is to undertake all our activities with the endeavour of meeting community expectations and achieving sustainable lifestyles.

The Framework includes:

- The Strategic Plan provides the broad future strategic direction for the City for the period 2008 2011;
- The 20-Year Financial Plan provides a broad overview of the major projects, programs and resource requirements over the next 4 years (The Plan includes 20-year financial projections);
- The Corporate Plan sets out the strategies and actions to develop internal systems and organisational capacity during 2008 2011 in order to achieve the commitments set out in the Strategic Plan;
- The Annual Plan which contains annual actions to achieve the vision of the Strategic Plan 2008 2011;
- Directorate Plans contain details of annual projects and programs to be delivered by each Directorate;
- Business Unit Action Plans contain details of the annual programs, services and activities for each Business Unit; and
- The Annual Budget.

Quarterly progress reports against the Annual Plan provide Council and the community with a full assessment of the City's progress in relation to the achievement of pre-determined milestones for major projects and programs. Full progress reports against the Capital Works Program will be provided at the same time as Annual Plan Progress Reports to Council.

#### Highlights - July to September Quarter

#### Key Focus Area 1 – Leadership and Governance

#### **Jinan Delegation**

Mayor Troy Pickard led a City of Joondalup Delegation to Jinan in September 2010. The Delegation comprised representatives from the City of Joondalup, Edith Cowan University and West Coast Institute of Training. The Delegation visited the Shanghai Better Cities, Better Life Expo en route and visited a number of pavilions which showcased examples of better practice in City development and urban design in countries throughout the world.

The Delegation was officially welcomed to Jinan at a civic dinner hosted by Mayor Zhang Jianguo and attended by a number of high level officials.

The Delegation conducted a number of meetings with officials from the Jinan Municipal People's Government including the Foreign Affairs Office, the Jinan Commerce Bureau and the Urban Administrative Bureau to progress cultural, economic and environmental initiatives.

The itinerary arranged for the Joondalup Delegation included a visit to the Jinan Garden located in the 7th China (Jinan) International Garden and Flower Expo, Jinan Vocational College, Jinan Number 9 Middle School, the Jinan Olympic Sports Centre and the Public Service Hotline.

#### Key Focus Area 2 – The Natural Environment

#### TravelSmart Awards

On 8 September 2010 the City accepted the TravelSmart Workplace Award for the development and implementation of the Green Transport Plan 2007-2009 at the Local Government TravelSmart Awards ceremony.

The City's TravelSmart Green Transport Plan was developed in 2007 to increase walking, cycling, public transport and car pool use by City staff travelling to and from the workplace. The aim of the Plan was to raise awareness of sustainable transport options for staff, focusing on environmental and health benefits of alternative methods of transport.

#### Waterwise Councils Program

The City of Joondalup is officially a *Waterwise Council* after being recognised by the Water Corporation and the Department of Water at the *Partners in Water Breakfast* on 5 August 2010. The City of Joondalup joined the Waterwise Council Program in October 2009 and has achieved the required criteria to be recognised as an accredited Waterwise Council.

Over the past year the City has implemented a number of water reduction initiatives that have led to significant savings in the amount of water consumed through City operations. These initiatives have included the implementation of a sustainable watering regime to increase water efficiency within the City's irrigation operations and completing a major hydrozoning and ecozoning project at Emerald Park, Edgewater. Overall the City has reduced its groundwater usage for 2009-2010 by 27% compared with the previous year.

#### Key Focus Area 3 – Economic Prosperity and Growth

#### **Regional Governance Framework**

A Strategic Position Statement was adopted by Council in July 2010 to support a Regional Governance Framework for the North West Corridor in conjunction with the City of Wanneroo. In August, Council endorsed a Regional Governance Framework as a basis for ongoing dialogue with the City of Wanneroo and State Government.

#### State Government Office Accommodation

The City lodged an Expression of Interest with the State Government for the Provision of Leased Office Accommodation in Metropolitan Activity Centres in September 2010.

#### **Business Forum**

As part of the City of Joondalup's commitment to local economic prosperity and growth, the City conducts regular Business Forums. A Business Forum entitled *Structuring for Growth* was held on 25 August 2010 with 84 people attending, including key State Government agencies and local stakeholders.

Ms Dale Page, Director Planning and Development of the City of Joondalup, discussed the implications of the City Centre Structure Plan for future growth of the Joondalup City Centre. The City also welcomed Mr Alex Taylor, General Manager Building Management from the Department of Treasury and Finance who introduced the key aspects of the Government Office Accommodation Master Planning Discussion Paper and discussed the implications of office relocations to suburban centres such as Joondalup.

#### Economic and Employment Strategy North West Sub Region

The City is working with the Department of Planning and the City of Wanneroo to establish employment self sufficiency targets for Activity Centres and to work together on a pilot project to develop an Economic and Employment Strategy for the North West sub region. This Strategy will become part of the overall Economic and Employment Strategy for the Perth Peel Region.

#### Key Focus Area 4 – The Built Environment

#### **Capital Works Program**

The July to September quarter saw significant progress or completion of a number of Capital Works Projects, including:

Playground Equipment Upgrades at:

- Penistone Park Greenwood; and
- Kilrenny Park Greenwood.

Tennis Court refurbishments at:

- Heathridge Park Heathridge;
- Blackboy Park Mullaloo;
- Emerald Park Edgewater;
- Warwick Open Space Warwick; and
- Glengarry Park Duncraig.

Black Spot upgrades at the intersections of:

- Joondalup Drive and Shenton Avenue in Joondalup New traffic signal upgrade; and
- Marmion Avenue and Hodges Drive in Joondalup New traffic signal upgrade.

#### Key Focus Area 5 – Community Wellbeing

#### Youth Forum

The City's *Speak Out Youth Forum* was held on Friday 17 September 2010. The opportunity to speak out on local community issues attracted 75 young people, aged between 12 and 18, from various public and private high schools within the City. Joondalup Youth Support Services also brought a group of young people from the local area who are currently homeless or at risk of becoming homeless. Their attendance ensured that the views of disadvantaged young people were represented.

The event was a great success with young people providing an insight into how the City can improve services for young people and the wider community. All the information and ideas provided by the young people will be presented in a report to a future Council meeting.

#### NAIDOC Week

NAIDOC Week is a nationwide celebration of the history, culture and achievements of Australia's Indigenous people. A range of activities were held to acknowledge the importance of local Indigenous culture. These included an official flag-raising ceremony at the City of Joondalup Administration Building, the *People in Mooro Country* publication launch, and an exhibition entitled *Nyoongar Dreamings* at the blend(er) gallery, NAIDOC Fun Day at Craigie Leisure Centre, the Kulbardi Boorndoon dance performance at Lakeside Shopping City, and *Unsung Heroes* @ Your Library workshops at the City of Joondalup libraries. The week's events were well received with over 1300 people attending.

#### Joondalup Eisteddfod

The City of Joondalup Eisteddfod is a performing arts competition which provides an opportunity for performers to showcase their skills in public. The event attracted over 450 participants with approximately 1200 members of the public attending the performances. The event concluded with the Eisteddfod Winners Concert on 17 September 2010.

#### Sunday Serenades:

The sixth concert in the Sunday Serenades Concert Series was held on 19 September 2010. The concert featured an Argentinean Tango group *Guapo* and was entitled *Tantalising Tango*. The concert was well attended with over 155 people enjoying the event.
