Yes	SLSWA managed Lifeguard services for nine Local Governments (including City of Joondalup) at 13 beach locations over the past summer season through 28 affiliated surf life saving clubs and seven support operations groups. SLSWA has access to over \$2million worth of emergency and rescue communications equipment and infrastructure and is part of a national body Surf Life Saving Australia which regulations, policy, research and development and best practice originate.	SLSWA has managed the previous CoJ Beach Lifeguard and Patrol service contracts over the past nine years and has developed a great understanding of the operations and patrol requirements. In addition to services provided to the City of Joondalup, SLSWA listed nine other local authorities, including the City of Wanneroo and the Town of Cottesloe, as clients to whom they provide similar services, thus demonstrating current experience.	It has successfully performed its obligations of previous Contracts for beach Lifeguard patrol services for the City. The Submission included an outline of the methodology and approach it would undertake to meet the service requirements for the next three summer seasons. Included was a description of how the Emergency Response Points function, with the provision of two lifeguards at each location per shift, as a minimum requirement.	SLSWA's principal location of business is in North Beach, with surf lifesaving clubs operating locally at Sorrento and Mullaloo. At these clubs, members are offered the opportunities for local employment.
