

Joondalup Sporting Achievement Grants Application Guidelines

Purpose

The Joondalup Sporting Achievement Grant provides financial assistance to individuals selected to represent Western Australia or Australia in their recognised sporting competition.

Guidelines

- To be eligible for a grant, individuals must:
 - be a resident of the City of Joondalup;
 - represent Western Australia or Australia at a recognised sporting competition (as a player or match official) either intrastate, interstate or overseas;
 - be under 18 years of age OR have a disability;
 - have support from the relevant governing association (documentation required);
 - have not received a grant in the current financial year. An exception will be made for those that receive the grant for State representation which results in a National team selection, those individuals will be eligible to apply for two grants within the same financial year;
 - have acquitted any previous grants from the City;
 - not apply for a grant retrospectively; and
 - not receive any personal financial gain from the grant.
- Grants will not be made to administrators, trainers or coaches.
- The program is administered on a monthly basis. Applicants will be notified of the outcome within six weeks of their application.
- In the event that an applicant has been successful in receiving a grant, but for whatever reason does not attend the competition for which the grant was provided, the applicant is required to return the grant to the City within two months.
- The City will budget annually for grants to provide financial assistance to Joondalup sport and recreation representatives. Grants will be awarded pending available funds.
- All successful applicants are required to acquit the grant within two months of the competition. Recipients who do not acquit the grant by the due date may be required to reimburse the City of Joondalup.
- Authority to approve applications is delegated to the Manager Leisure and Cultural Services provided all necessary criteria for approval of applications are met.

Grant Allocation

| State representation in competition outside Western Australia | 200.00 |
| National representation in competition (local, interstate or overseas) | 300.00 |
