Notes to the Enrolment Eligibility Claims Form

1 When to use this form	You may make a claim for eligibility using this form at any time. However if you want to be on the roll for a particular election you must give your claim form to the City of Joondalup more than 50 days before the election date.
2 Who should use this form	You should fill in this form if you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> own or occupy 3 rateable property in the City of Joondalup but are not on the residents roll for the City of Joondalup; or qualify under the <i>Local Government Act 1995</i>^{7*}, and want to be able to vote at City of Joondalup elections.
3 Who is an occupier	To qualify as an occupier you must have a right, under a lease, tenancy agreement or other legal instrument, to be in continuous occupation of the property for at least the next 3 months. When the Chief Executive Officer of the City of Joondalup is considering your claim, he may ask you for a copy of your lease or tenancy agreement to support your claim. You do not need to provide a copy unless asked.
4 Silent address	If having your address on the roll would put your safety, or that of your family, at risk you may ask the Chief Executive Office not to show your address on the roll. To do this you must give to the Chief Executive Officer a statutory declaration setting out the reasons why you do not want your address shown on the roll.
5 Rateable property	If you own or occupy more than one property in the City of Joondalup, give details of them all. Add additional pages if necessary.
6 Which ward	If the property in respect of which this claim is made is partly in one ward and partly in another the corporate body may choose which of those wards the claim is to apply to. If this box is left blank the Chief Executive Officer of the City of Joondalup will decide which ward the claim is to apply to. In this form the ward, or if no ward is applicable, the district, is referred to as “the electorate.” <ul style="list-style-type: none"> North Ward – Burns Beach, Kinross, Iluka, Currambine, Joondalup North Central Ward – Ocean Reef, Mullaloo, Heathridge, Edgewater, Connolly Central Ward – Beldon, Kallaroo, Craigie, Woodvale South West Ward – Hillarys, Padbury, Sorrento South East Ward – Kingsley, Greenwood South Ward – Marmion, Duncraig, Warwick
7 Qualification under the Local Government Act	To qualify under the <i>Local Government Act 1995</i> [*] you must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> own or occupy rateable property in the City of Joondalup; have been on the last electoral roll prepared under the <i>Local Government Act 1960</i> for the former City of Wanneroo; and have owned or occupied rateable property in the City of Joondalup continuously since that roll was prepared.
8 Nominations	A nomination must be made in writing and be signed by all or a majority of the owners or occupiers of the property (or if the owner or occupier is a corporate body, be signed by an officer of the corporate body) in accordance with the <i>Local Government (Elections) Regulations 1997</i> . If you are a nominee, an Application to Register a Nominee form must also be completed and returned to the City of Joondalup with this Enrolment Eligibility form. If a corporate body or group of people owns or occupies more than one property in the City of Joondalup, a nomination applies to all of those properties.
9 Duration of enrolment	If your enrolment eligibility claim is accepted it will remain valid for the next 2 (or in limited circumstances, next 3) ordinary elections held for the City of Joondalup, if you have enrolled as a non-resident occupier. If you wish to continue to qualify as an elector after that, you will need to make another enrolment eligibility claim. For non-resident owners, the claim will remain valid until you cease to own the rateable property on which the claim is based.
10 Confidentiality	Your date of birth, phone and fax numbers and email address supplied in this form will be kept confidential and will be used only by the City of Joondalup and the Western Australian Electoral Commission for the purpose of preparing local government electoral rolls.
11 Where to send your form	When you have completed and signed this form, send it to the Chief Executive Officer of the City of Joondalup, PO Box 21 Joondalup WA 6919. You may send it by post, by fax or by other electronic means so long as it is capable of being printed in its entirety, including a signature. If you send it by fax or electronically you should check that it has been received.
12 Change of Address/Details	If you are currently enrolled as an elector for the City of Joondalup and you wish to advise of a change of address or any other enrolment details, please do not complete this form. Simply advise the City of Joondalup in writing of the amended details to your enrolment.
