Conditions of Use

By clicking on the Accept button you are agreeing to abide by the conditions set out below.

Customers agree that they are allowed to use Internet and e-mail facilities within the City of Joondalup Libraries subject to the following conditions:

Any person who uses a computer and/or internet service (including Wi-Fi) provided by Libraries, acknowledges that pursuant to sections 99 to 102 of the *Classification (Publications, Films and Computer Games) Enforcement Act 1996*, it is a criminal offence to:

1. Obtain possession of, transmit, advertise or request the transmission of **objectionable material**; or
2. Transmit to or make **restricted material** available to a child.

Any person considered to be in breach of either section 101 or section 102 will be referred to the appropriate authorities.

The Library reserves the right to determine if particular material is offensive, objectionable or otherwise inappropriate for viewing/accessing in the Library.

Customers understand:

- That the Libraries' internet service is filtered and some sites may be blocked, and acknowledge that no filtering software is totally accurate, so not all offensive and inappropriate sites are blocked.
- That the City cannot guarantee security of confidential information which may be entered by customers online, for example onto websites, web based forms or emails.

- That the City is not responsible for accuracy of information obtained online.
- That the City cannot be held responsible for breaks in service resulting from technical problems outside our control.
- That Libraries cannot guarantee extensions to a booking period for use of computing facilities.
- That they must not modify or gain access to restricted files or data belonging to others. This includes using someone else's Library card number to access resources, or accessing a computer that is logged on to another person.
- That they must not damage equipment or alter the configuration of the Library computers.
- Customers must not use their personal software on the Library's computers.
- Security on the internet cannot be guaranteed. The City takes no responsibility for any consequences, direct or indirect, arising from customers' use of particular sites.
- The Libraries computers and/or internet services are not to be used for any unlawful or inappropriate purpose.

Penalties

Customers understand that if they breach these conditions, their use of library facilities may be suspended or terminated at the discretion of the Chief Executive Officer.
