# WA BAG BAN CAMPAIGN KIT

From 1 January 2019, it is illegal for any retailer in Western Australia to supply lightweight plastic shopping bags.

The legislation was introduced by the WA Government on 1 July 2018 and retailers have had 6 months to phase out their existing stocks of banned bags. From 1 January 2019, members of the public will be able to report suspected banned bags and, if found non-compliant, retailers can be fined \$5000.

Over the past few months, the National Retail Association has visited thousands of retailers across WA to provide advice and assistance in preparation for the bag ban.

Many businesses have already made the transition away from lightweight plastic bags, however we have found that some consumers are still unaware that the ban also applies to small and medium businesses, including food outlets.

#### **JANUARY CAMPAIGN**

To minimise negative impacts on business, the National Retail Association has partnered with the WA Government to launch another state-wide campaign from 1 January.

The campaign is fresh and modern, and focuses on positive messages to thank and support retailers.
