The City of Joondalup Inside-Out Billboard Project

The City of Joondalup's first Inside-Out Billboard was installed in March 2014 on the west facing side of the Joondalup Library and the second in March 2016 at the Joondalup Courthouse.

The Inside-Out Billboard Project provides the public with the opportunity to view contemporary artworks by Western Australian artists commissioned by the City of Joondalup. Each artwork is on display for six months at the Joondalup Library and then re-displayed in the same order at the Joondalup Courthouse site.

Artworks are commissioned by artists exhibiting in either the City of Joondalup annual Community Art Exhibition or Invitation Art Prize (previously Community Invitation Art Award).
