The City of Joondalup has paid parking within the Joondalup City Centre. Parking fees are only applicable Monday to Friday. Parking in the City Centre is free on weekends.

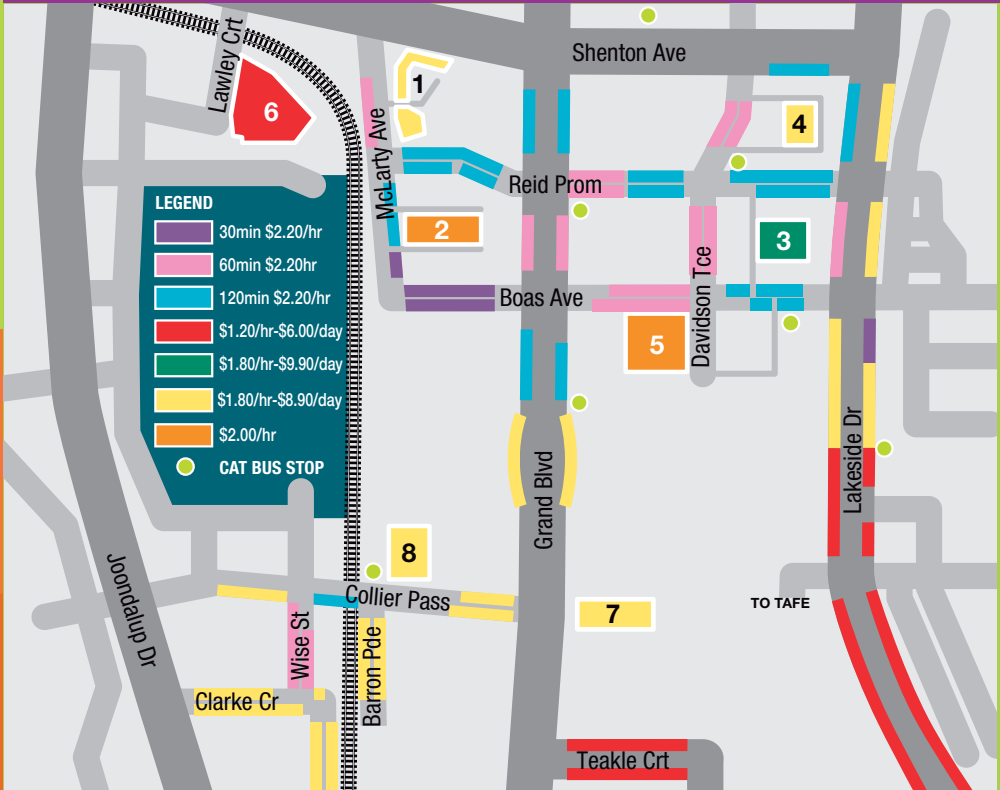
Paid parking is crucial to ensure that parking is effectively regulated to support local businesses during the busy working week. Encouraging a high turnover of parking bay use provides greater convenience for patrons seeking to park closer to the businesses they wish to visit. Visitors will return to the City more frequently if convenient parking is more readily available.

Revenue generated from paid parking is used to fund the City's future parking facility needs as the City continues to mature as the second CBD to Perth. This will result in the development of a continuous improvement and enhancement program for parking services.

Free parking on a Saturday and Sunday now means visitors and shoppers can use the City's on-street and off-street parking bays at no cost, any time over weekends. The removal of paid parking on weekends enhances the vibrancy of the Joondalup City Centre and also increases visitor numbers and benefits local businesses.

\$1.20/hr - \$6.00 day maximum
(245 bays - 3 Disabled/2 M/cycle bays.
104 permit only)
- 7. Central Park West Car Park**
\$1.80/hr - \$8.90 day maximum
(33 bays - 1 Disabled)
- 8. Collier Pass Car Park**
\$1.80/hr - \$8.90 day maximum
(91 bays - 4 M/cycle)



Short Term Parking

A range of short term parking is available within the central areas of the City Centre. These range in maximum time limits of 30 minutes, 1 and 2 hours. Short term parking is designed to encourage a high turnover of vehicles in locations of high demand by business patrons.

Long Term Parking

For those wishing to park in the City Centre for a longer period of time, cheaper long term parking is available on the fringes of the

City Centre, both in off street car parks and on street parking bays. Please note a daily/weekly ticket does not guarantee a parking bay.

Motorcycle Parking

Do you ride a motorcycle or scooter? More than 60 motorcycle bays are provided throughout the City of Joondalup. Where motorcycles park in the designated on street parking bays, appropriate time restrictions apply, however within most off street car parks, time restrictions do not apply.
