1. OVERVIEW

1.1 The Project

Each year the local community comes together to showcase the very best talent, energy and creativity of its local community at Joondalup's Twilight Lantern Parade.

While next year's event may appear a little different, the City is committed to ensuring the safety of the community and will continue to monitor all relevant directions relating to COVID-19 in accordance with the State Government.

1.2 Get Involved

The Twilight Lantern Parade provides students, teachers and artists the opportunity to:

- promote creativity
- develop skills, knowledge, capacity and capabilities
- use innovative art practices to express ideas
- gain insight and understanding of local cultures, history and art practices
- incorporate community and collective ownership
- promote social inclusion and equality, by respecting diversity and inclusive of differences
- develop pride and empower students and community members
- creatively collaborate in a valued team environment
- use basic elements of auditory, visual, tactile and/or kinaesthetic experiences to experiment and develop practices in and across art forms



2. WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

All schools, across Western Australia are encouraged to participate in the Twilight Lantern Parade in 2021.

2.1 How Can You Participate?

Due to the current COVID-19 restrictions, the City will have a limited capacity for participants in the 2021 parade and places will be offered to the first schools who register.

The following school packages are available:

- **Gold Package**

The Twilight Lantern Parade Gold Package is an artist-facilitated school program available to schools within the City of Joondalup. Schools that apply for this program will be matched with a professional artist who will design and help create their parade entry.

Please note, there is only a limited number of Gold packages available and will be offered to the first schools to register. (See page 8 for more detail)

- **Silver Package**

The Twilight Lantern Parade Silver package is a funding opportunity to assist schools in purchasing materials to create their own parade entries. (See page 8 for more details).

On top of the two packages being offered for the 2021 Twilight Lantern Parade, any school that completed their 2020 Under the Sea lanterns can apply to showcase their lanterns.

2.2 The Commitment

Participating schools in the Twilight Lantern Parade will be required to provide the following:

Gold Package (for schools within the City of Joondalup boundaries only)

- **Parent and teacher support** – to assist with parade workshops, and supervision on Parade Day.
- **Workshop venue** – to provide an appropriate space in which to conduct lantern-making workshops at your school. This may include an area to house large-scale lanterns whilst construction is in progress throughout Term One.
- **Collection of recycled materials** – to collect recycled materials for use in the project.
- **Basic art room equipment and materials:** The City's support package will cover the cost of bulk materials required for the Parade entry. Schools will be responsible for basic art supplies, e.g. glue, scissors, etc.

All Participants

- **Parental permission** – for students to take part in the Parade.
- **Student supervision** – for participating students on the day of the Parade
- **Designated contact person** – schools participating in the event must elect a designated teacher and parent to be the liaison for the duration of this program.

2.3 Important Dates

3. TO REGISTER

If your school wishes to be involved, simply complete the Online Entry Form available on the City's website at joondalup.wa.gov.au.

Expressions of Interest close Monday 7 December 2020. Participating schools will be contacted to confirm participation by Monday 14 December 2020.

4. DISPOSAL OF LANTERNS

The City of Joondalup cannot store lanterns made by schools, as part of the artist-in-residence program or your own in-school workshops. When leaving the parade site all lanterns you wish to keep must be taken with you. Lanterns left on site will be disposed of by the City.

5. DUTY OF CARE

The City will make every effort to ensure the safety of participants in the Parade. All artists and art groups involved in the parade are covered by public liability insurance and have completed a Working with Children Check.

The City has public liability insurance that indemnifies the City against any act or omission of negligence by the City's elected members, employees or volunteers.

If the Department of Education authorises the excursion, the Department has general liability cover (includes public liability cover) where schools are protected through the Department when a school or an employee has proven to be negligent. There is no personal accident cover for students attending this excursion.

Schools must obtain students legal guardian permission to participate in the Lantern Parade.

Schools are required to supervise all students in the parade and parents will need to deliver and collect their children from teachers at the designated assembly area.

6. COVID-19 AND THE PARADE

The City will continue to monitor all relevant directions relating to COVID-19 and follow the appropriate State Government advice. The 2021 Twilight Lantern Parade will be a COVID safe event and a range of measures will be implemented to ensure the safety of patrons, staff, facilitators and performers.

In line with the current COVID-19 restrictions, only students, teachers and designated contact parents will be able to participate in the 2021 Parade.



7. SCHOOL PARADE PACKAGES IN DETAIL

GOLD PACKAGE:

The Twilight Lantern Parade Gold Package is an artist-facilitated school program available to schools within the City of Joondalup. The program offers schools a professional artist to facilitate lantern workshops in helping design and create their Parade entry. Due to the nature of this program, school places are limited.

Between two and five workshops will be offered to schools in this program, in both design and puppet making, as well as a follow-up workshop in performance and puppetry.

Please note, the scope, size and quantity of these workshops will be negotiated between the allocated artist and school, with assistance from the City of Joondalup Arts Officer. Workshop scheduling and content will largely be determined by the number of participants, level of school support provided and the nature and size of the entry.

Workshops will take place in schools throughout Term One, 2021.

What is included in this package?

- Artist to facilitate school-based workshops
- Most of the materials required
- Associated financial support
- Participation in the Twilight Lantern Parade to be held on **Saturday 27 March 2021**

SILVER PACKAGE:

The Twilight Lantern Parade Silver package is a funding opportunity to assist schools in purchasing materials to create their own parade entries. Schools applying for this option will not have access to artist facilitated workshops.

Please note the City endeavours to include all interested schools in this package. However, due to budget limitations, if applications exceed available funding, priority will be offered on a first come basis.

What is included in this package?

- Financial support to assist the making of lanterns
- Participation in the Twilight Lantern Parade to be held on **Saturday 27 March 2021**
