Online resources include Australian and international databases, an encyclopaedia and language-learning tools, plus links to top quality free resources on the internet.



SF Britannica Library



This online encyclopaedia delivers instant results to all your questions in three levels of reading ability: kids, teens and adults. After choosing a level, you can explore features such as articles, an atlas and timelines as well as magazine articles, images, videos, and links to other websites.

ProQuest – Research Library

This database provides one-stop access to more than 4,000 periodicals from one of the broadest, most inclusive general reference databases ProQuest has to offer. Search from a highly-respected, diversified mix of scholarly journals, trade publications and magazines covering over 150 academic disciplines.

Informit offers full text, Australian content databases in the subject areas of Literature and Culture, Humanities and Social Sciences, Families and Society and Indigenous Culture and History.

Finding the full text

Looking for copies of articles that aren't available in full text through the Libraries' databases?

Try searching the internet using the article title – often university websites or online journals have articles available free of charge even if Proquest or Informit don't provide the full text of an article you want.
