Since May 2017 the City of Joondalup has been implementing the Leafy City Program which aims to increase canopy cover by planting trees within the City's suburban streetscapes. This will create cooler, more inviting green urban spaces for residents and mitigate the increasing heat-island effect generated by existing hardstand surfaces.

## When will the program roll out?

The next round of tree planting will commence in May through to August 2021 supported by the advice and planning of the City's arborist, landscape architects and traffic engineers. Residents will be informed prior to works commencing in their areas.
