ACCEPTED MATERIALS THROUGH THE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE PROGRAM

- ✓ Acids and Alkalis
- ✓ Aerosols
- ✓ Batteries (household)
- ✓ Engine Coolants & Glycols
- ✓ Fire Extinguishers - Non halon (red) only
- ✓ Flammables
- ✓ Flares
- ✓ Fluorescent Lamps and Tubes (CFLs)
- ✓ Gas Cylinders (small household)
- ✓ Household Chemicals and Cleaners
- ✓ Paint
- ✓ Pesticides/Herbicides
- ✓ Poisons/Toxics
- ✓ Pool Chemicals
- ✓ Smoke Detectors
- ✓ Unknown Chemicals accepted at most facilities (except Albany) and must be in sealed, chemical resistant containers

The Program can only accept 20kg or litres per material type and only domestic waste (no business waste accepted).

You do not need to be a resident of the Local Governments managing these facilities to be able to drop off your household hazardous waste for free.

THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS ARE NOT ACCEPTED THROUGH THE PROGRAM:

- ✗ Asbestos
- ✗ Commercial & Industrial Waste
- ✗ Electronic Waste
- ✗ EPIRBs & PLBs
- ✗ Explosives, Ammunition & Firearms
- ✗ Fire extinguishers - Halon (yellow)
- ✗ Medications & Pharmaceuticals
- ✗ Mobile Phones
- ✗ Motor oil & Cooking oil
- ✗ Printer Cartridges/Toners
- ✗ Sharps & Needles
- ✗ Tyres
