City of Joondalup is excited to announce that the Community Art Project will be returning for 2023 Joondalup Festival. In 2023 the City will be working with artist Sean Adamas to create *Soaring: Hopes and Dreams*.

1. OVERVIEW

1.1 The Project

Soaring: Hopes and Dreams is a participative arts project showcasing the talent, energy, and creativity of the local community.

Students and Community Groups from within the City of Joondalup are offered the opportunity to partake in a community art installation that will be on display during the 2023 Joondalup Festival. The theme of the artwork is hopes and dreams, where each artist is encouraged to express their aspirations for the future.

The installation will be displayed over the three-week festival period. There are 20 sets of wings that will be allocated to schools and 5 wings that will be allocated for Community Groups.

Each participating school and community group will be provided with a pair of wings to work, made from plywood. There is flexibility for teachers/groups to allocate sections of the wings for each participant, or work on the group canvas as a collective. Teachers/groups are welcome to tailor the project to suit various art styles (impressionism, cubism, etc.) and are welcome to use paint or print techniques.

Each set of wings will be approximately 1m – 1.5m tall. Whilst participants are welcome to use the back of the wings, it must be clear upon collection which way will be the 'front'.

1.2 How to participate

To participate, schools will need to fill in the Expression of Interest form on the City's website by **Friday 14 October 2022**.

Successful applicants will be notified by **Friday 21 October 2022** and will include a project brief and meeting schedule with the Artist.

1.4 Who can be involved?

All schools and community groups across the City of Joondalup are encouraged to participate in the *Soaring: Hopes and Dreams* community art project.

Please note that spaces are limited.

1.5 What is the school's commitment?

Participating schools need to provide:

- Teacher support: To have all artwork ready to collect by **Monday 27 February 2023**, the teacher will need to plan classes accordingly.
- Basic art room equipment and materials needed to create artworks.
- Designated contact person: It is encouraged that schools participating in the project elect a designated teacher to be the liaison for the duration of this program. This contact person must be the person filling out EOI form.

1.7 What is the community group's commitment??

Participating schools need to provide:

- A designated contact to liaise with the group and the artist.
- Ability to attend a workshop should the group not have available supplies.

2. WHY BE INVOLVED?

Soaring: Hopes and Dreams is an exciting project that hopes to invigorate a renewed positive energy in post pandemic life.

The project endeavours to inspire:

- Creativity and imagination;
- Expand knowledge on various artforms (painting and sculptural installation);
- Develop pride in school, community, and individual efforts;
- Explore ideas in the arts by using observation, curiosity, research and imagination;
- Understand the importance of small contributions to create large scale artwork; and
- Encourage social learning.
