This is the Whitford Library.



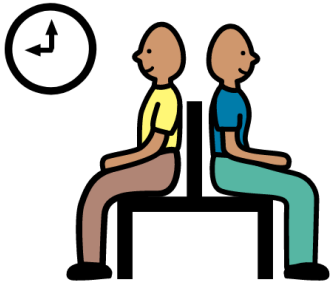
There will be other children, parents, and library staff. I can bring my own laptop.



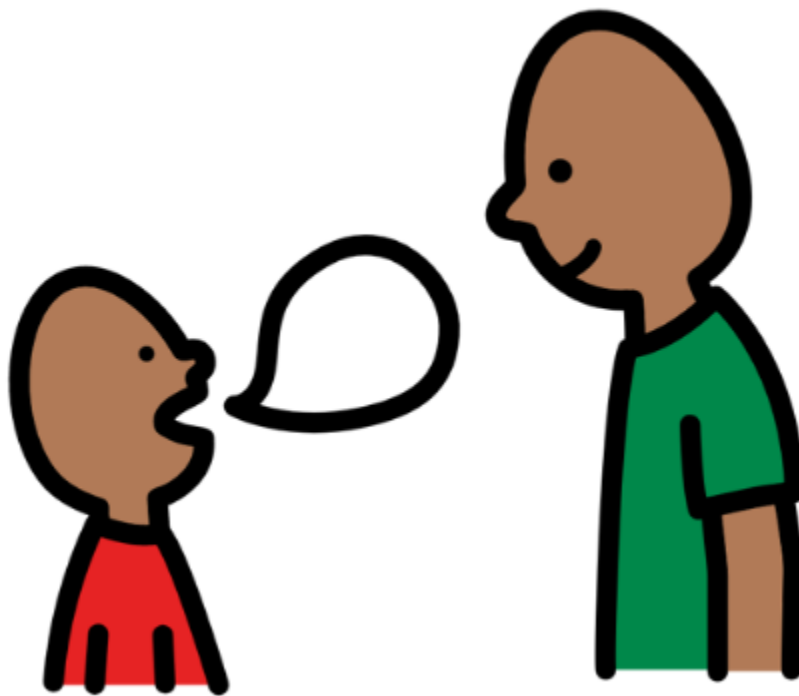
At Coder Dojo I will learn computer skills, learn how to code, use programs like HTML, Scratch, and Python programming and have fun!
