

## 2022/23 Waterwise Verge Rebate Program Eligible Materials

The City's [Waterwise Verge Rebate Program](#) encourages and supports residents to create [waterwise verge gardens](#) and aims to support positive environmental impacts such as increased biodiversity, canopy cover and ecological corridors and reduced greenhouse gas emissions and water use.

The City of Joondalup's Waterwise Verge Rebate Program provides successful applicants with a \$250.00 voucher to use at a participating waterwise garden centre or nursery.

To be a participant of the Program, you are required to submit an [Expression of Interest](#) and formally be accepted into the Program by the City.

Participants in the Program will be able to purchase the following **eligible** items with the unique voucher issued by the City:

- Waterwise Australian native plants or non-native plants listed on the Water Corporation's [waterwise plant directory](#). Our preference is that the plants are WA natives.
- Waterwise Mulch (pine bark, whole tree prunings)\*
- Compost\*\*
- Waterwise soil wetting agent\*\*
- Waterwise soil improvers, minerals, nutrients, trace elements and amendments\*\*
- Controlled release fertiliser/slow release native fertiliser\*\*
- Equipment such as a spade, shovel, rake, buckets, and watering can.

\* Keep in mind plant pathogens and pests when selecting your mulch.

\*\* Select certified water efficient products, such as products with Water Corporation's Waterwise product logo.

Participants of the Program are **not eligible** to use the issued voucher to purchase:

- Cost of contractors or consultants
- Cost of delivery of plants, mulch or other items
- Structures such as bird baths, statues, art sculptures etc
- Lighting
- Planter boxes
- Retaining walls
- Trees
- Landscaping
- Loose rocks and gravel
- Prickly and poisonous plants or declared weeds
- Lawn
- Synthetic turf
- Paving.
