Education providers in the City of Joondalup are leading the way in emerging high demand skill areas including user experience designers, software engineers, data scientists, mobile application developers and project managers.

WA'S BIGGEST CYBER SECURITY ECO-SYSTEM

Edith Cowan University is one of only two federal government recognised Academic Centres of Cyber Security Excellence in Australia - with the Cyber Security Cooperative Research Centre (CSCRC) and the ECU Security Research Institute (ECUSRI) based here.

These internationally recognised leaders in multidisciplinary security science research are housed in a purpose-built world class cyber security research and training facility which was established with academic, government and industry partners attracting around \$140million of funding.

AUSTRALIAN AUTOMATION AND ROBOTICS PRECINCT

The Western Australian Government has invested \$20million in the Australian Automation and Robotics Precinct (AARP) to progress the testing, research and development of emerging technologies.

Just 8km from Joondalup, the AARP will help to attract 5,000 new highly skilled jobs to the region to support research and development within the precinct.
