Artist in Focus

Afsaneh Khoramshahi

Winner of the Artist in Focus award, 2022 Community Art Exhibition.

Coming later this year is a solo exhibition by Afsaneh Khoramshahi for the City of Joondalup's annual *Artist in Focus* exhibition. This award offers the artist a solo exhibition hosted by the City of Joondalup in addition to mentoring and guidance.

Afsaneh Khoramshahi is an Iranian-Australian illustrator and author of children's books. She also works as a Persian carpet designer working with a carpet studio in Munich, Germany. Afsaneh's art focuses on folks and fables from ancient Iran and traditional poems that were written more than 500 years ago. Her paintings bring to life realistic and imaginary worlds, immersing the audience in a magical and surreal world.
