- All concerts are held at **Redmond Theatre**, in the Performing Arts Centre at **Prendiville Catholic College**, Ocean Reef. Please see the map on page 13 for more information on where to park and access the venue.

- Doors open 15 minutes before each concert. Please note that there is not a lot of available seating in the pre-concert waiting area, so we suggest you don't arrive too early.
- There is no allocated seating for Sunday Serenades concerts. All seats in Redmond Theatre offer a clear, unobstructed view of the stage area.
- There is ample free parking available at Prendiville Catholic College, including accessible bays for ACROD Cardholders. See the map on page 13 for more information.
