Common Name

Mugga Ironbark

Botanical Name

Eucalyptus sideroxylon

Origin

Native to South-eastern Queensland, New South Wales and Victoria.

Description

A medium-sized tree growing up to 25 meters high. The tree has distinctive red brown bark which dramatically contrasts with the weeping narrow grey-blue foliage.

From winter to early spring, it produces pink to red flowers in clusters of seven. This tree is a great habitat for native fauna and is a valuable source for honey production.

They are an extremely hardy tree that tolerates a wide range of soil types, weather conditions and is resistant to *Phytophthora cinnamoni* (Dieback)
