Eight and four years ago residents of the North Central Ward voted me in as Councillor.
My mandate at both elections was to push the development of Ocean Reef Marina.
I did just that and now we have two new breakwaters 8 m high with building to commence shortly. This project in our ward is expected to provide a $\$ 3$ billion injection into our local economy. Its forecast to create 950 jobs, creating a thriving coastal hub that will be a landmark coastal attraction for the local residents. The development will feature Perth's first ocean pool, extensive boating facilities, retail and hospitality venues and mixed-use developments.
