Report Objective

To provide professional opinion on the health status and integrity of 1x large gum tree situated in the boundary line Gibson Ave, Padbury.

Rationale for the proposed landscape amendment

Report permitted due to the council concerns of the health status and care taken to the large gum tree.

Provide recommendations of works required in order to prevent further damage during construction.

Findings & Recommendations

From visual inspection, and in my professional opinion I find the Eucalyptus located on the front boundary line of 77 Gibson Ave to have significant signs of decay.

Decay visualisations are found to be from Borer. Eucalyptus has significant hollow sounds on sound test confirming presence with active bee hives also present.

Whilst the Eucalyptus is currently showing epicormic growth, this in essence is the last attempt of resprout.

The Borer infection has significantly compromised the health of the eucalyptus with the epicormic growth dying off in the near future.

Maintenance and management will not slow the decay nor will it be able to reverse the decay and remove the Borer from the mature tree.
