

## Joondalup Libraries – Conditions of Entry

Welcome to Joondalup Libraries. Our libraries aim to provide a safe and welcoming space for all members of the community to access services, resources and programs.

We ask that you conduct yourself in a way that is respectful of place, property and people.

## By entering the library, you agree to be bound by the following conditions of entry:

- Behave in a respectful and appropriate manner towards others and the Library.
- Ensure children 12 years and under are supervised at all times.
- Always follow any staff directions, including any direction to leave the Library.
- Make any bags, folders, property or equipment available for inspection by Library staff.
- Abide by any requirements relating to the use of Library internet, WiFi and computer resources.
- Place rubbish in bins provided.

## You WILL NOT:

- Cause distress or fear to persons.
- Assault, threaten, intimidate or harass.
- Disrupt other visitors, Library staff or the Library operations.
- Run in or around the Library.
- Swear or use abusive or offensive language.
- Consume alcohol, smoke, vape, administer or consume illicit drugs.
- Enter the Library under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Leave any belongings or items unattended (any unattended belongings will be removed, and staff will dispose of unclaimed items or hand them to the WA Police).
- Speak loudly, use mobile phones and/or listen to music of a volume that others find disturbing or disruptive.
- Make excessive noise.
- Undertake fund raising (including selling raffle tickets).

- Distribute a petition or conduct a survey.
- Use audio or visual recording device without written approval.
- Take photos or other imagery of a person without that person's consent.
- Solicit a business, display or access offensive or objectionable material such as pornography, expressions of racial hatred or representations of violence.
- Use Library systems (including internet, computer and network systems), property, assets or processes inappropriately or illegally.
- Bring a dog or animal into the library (including foyer), unless a certified Guide, Hearing or Assistance animal.
- Ride or use scooters, bikes, roller-skates, rollerblades in the Library or surrounding outdoor spaces.
- Bring bicycles into the Library.
- Charge eVehicles (e.g. e-Scooters, e-Bikes).

The City of Joondalup has installed a closed-circuit television (CCTV) system in and around the Library. By entering the Library, you acknowledge that you will be filmed by the CCTV cameras. The City reserves the right to use the recordings made by CCTV for lawful purposes.

**"Library"** refers to the library building, as well as the surrounding outdoor spaces, including entranceways, patios, verandas, and carparks.

## If these Conditions of Entry or any laws are breached, the City of Joondalup reserves the right to:

- 1. Direct any person to leave the library immediately.
- 2. Remove any person in breach of these Conditions of Entry or any law including the *City of Joondalup Local Government and Public Property Local Law*.
- 3. Cancel (temporarily or permanently) a person's Library membership.
- 4. Use security staff or call on Western Australian Police Officers to remove a person, and resort to prosecution if warranted.
- 5. Ban the person from entry to the Library (temporarily or permanently).

A person who enters any City of Joondalup Library while they are under a ban is trespassing and may be removed by security staff or Western Australian Police officers.
