Investing in a Joondalup Health and Medical Hub will deliver world class medical research, talent, technology and allied health services to the region

Joondalup is a place where state-of-the-art facilities, the latest medical technology, healthcare professionals, researchers, entrepreneurs and investors come together to develop innovative solutions to address healthcare challenges now and in the future.

The Joondalup Health and Medical Hub will deliver economic benefits, improved patient outcomes and provide innovative research opportunities, benefitting 500,000 people living within 20 minutes of the Joondalup City Centre.

The opportunity

Joondalup is home to the largest health care facility in the northern suburbs of metropolitan Perth, with the 722-bed Joondalup Health Campus, which operates as a public/private partnership model. A new mental health facility has added an additional 102 beds, with a revamp of the private hospital expected to add a further 85 beds.

The health services industry is the leading employer in the region, complemented by significant education and training opportunities through neighbouring Edith Cowan University and North Metropolitan TAFE.

Meaningful impacts

A \$256 million plan to expand JHC has created an opportunity to develop a world class health precinct. The City and its health partners are focused on developing a regional medical cluster in the areas of research, talent, technology, and allied health, to meet the needs of the northern corridor.

As a centre of health innovation and research, Joondalup is leading in several key areas of specialist health including:

- cancer care and treatment;
- mental health;
- exercise and sports science;
- neurological research;
- nursing and midwifery; and
- allied health services and psychology.

Home to world-leading research and unique educational facilities including Linear Clinical Research and the AMA Training College, Joondalup offers partners the ability to leverage an established network of collaborators and access the latest research, technology and infrastructure.

Supported by the City's recently commissioned Medical Gap Analysis, the City is working to position Joondalup as a health and medical hub for industry investment, talent and the broader community.
